According to the terms and conditions of your Cooperative Use License Agreement with the County of Suffolk for the Long Island Greenbelt Trail Conference, Inc. to make available to the County of Suffolk and its residents, interpretive and informational opportunities at the Blydenburgh-Weld House in Blydenburgh County Park, Smithtown, and the Trailside Information and Exhibit Center in Robert Cushman Murphy County Park, the First Amendment Cooperative Use License Agreement term ended December 31, 2012. The Cooperative Use License agreement provided for two five-year options at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation. The Cooperative Use License Agreement will require a formal amendment to grant the final option period.

The county wishes to renew the agreement and exercise the final option period through December 31, 2017. If Long Island Greenbelt Trail Conference, Inc. wishes to continue their Cooperative Use License Agreement for Blydenburgh County Park and Robert Cushman Murphy County Park, please indicate your agreement by signing where indicated and returning this letter to us at the address below.

All other terms and conditions of the Cooperative Use License agreement dated May 11, 2004 and the First Amendment of Cooperative Use License Agreement dated March 28, 2012 will remain in full force and effect.
